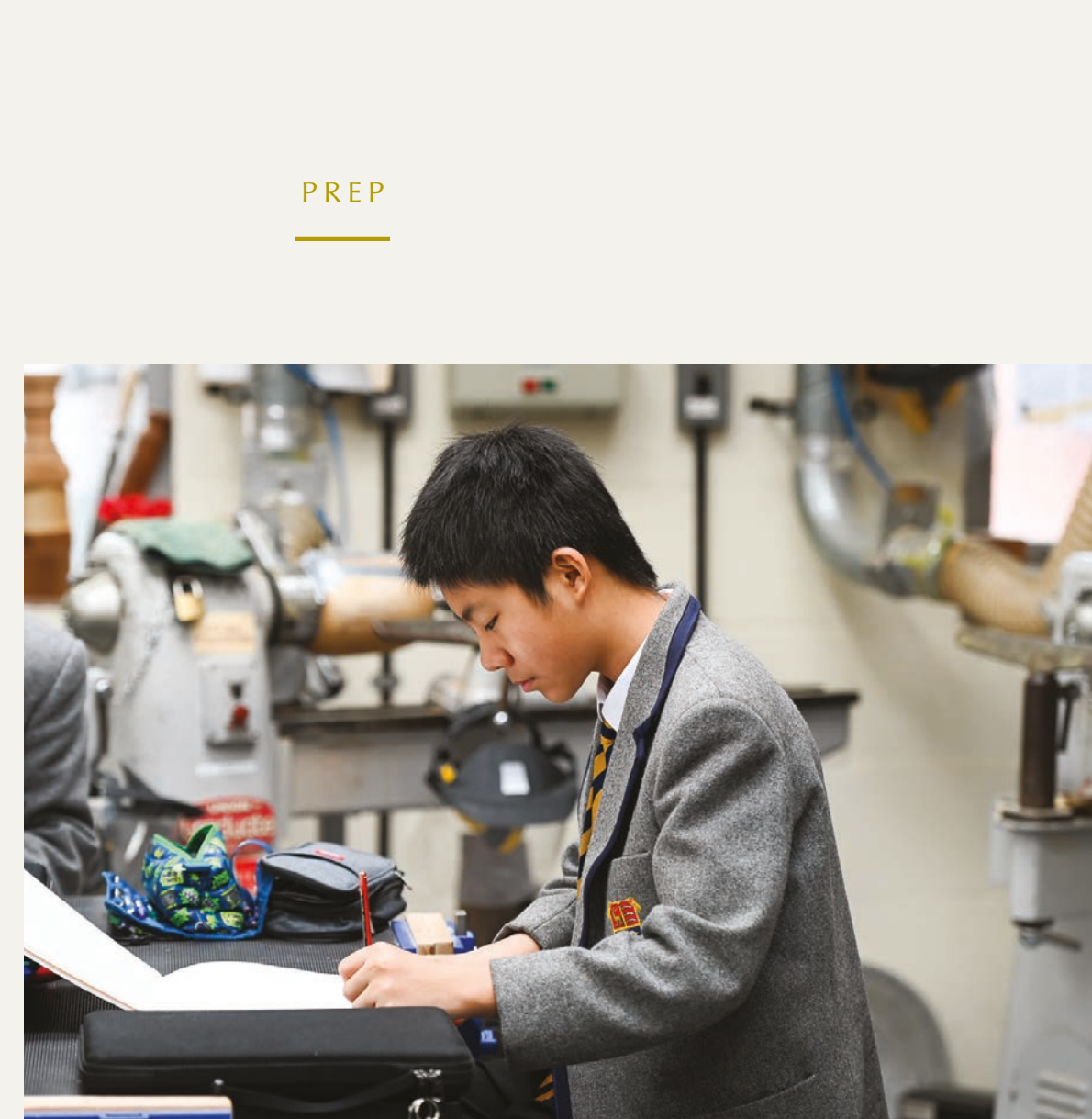
Prep School

We're about more than just academic study. Our wide-ranging opportunities beyond the classroom give your child the chance to develop those key personal and social skills which will set them up for life.

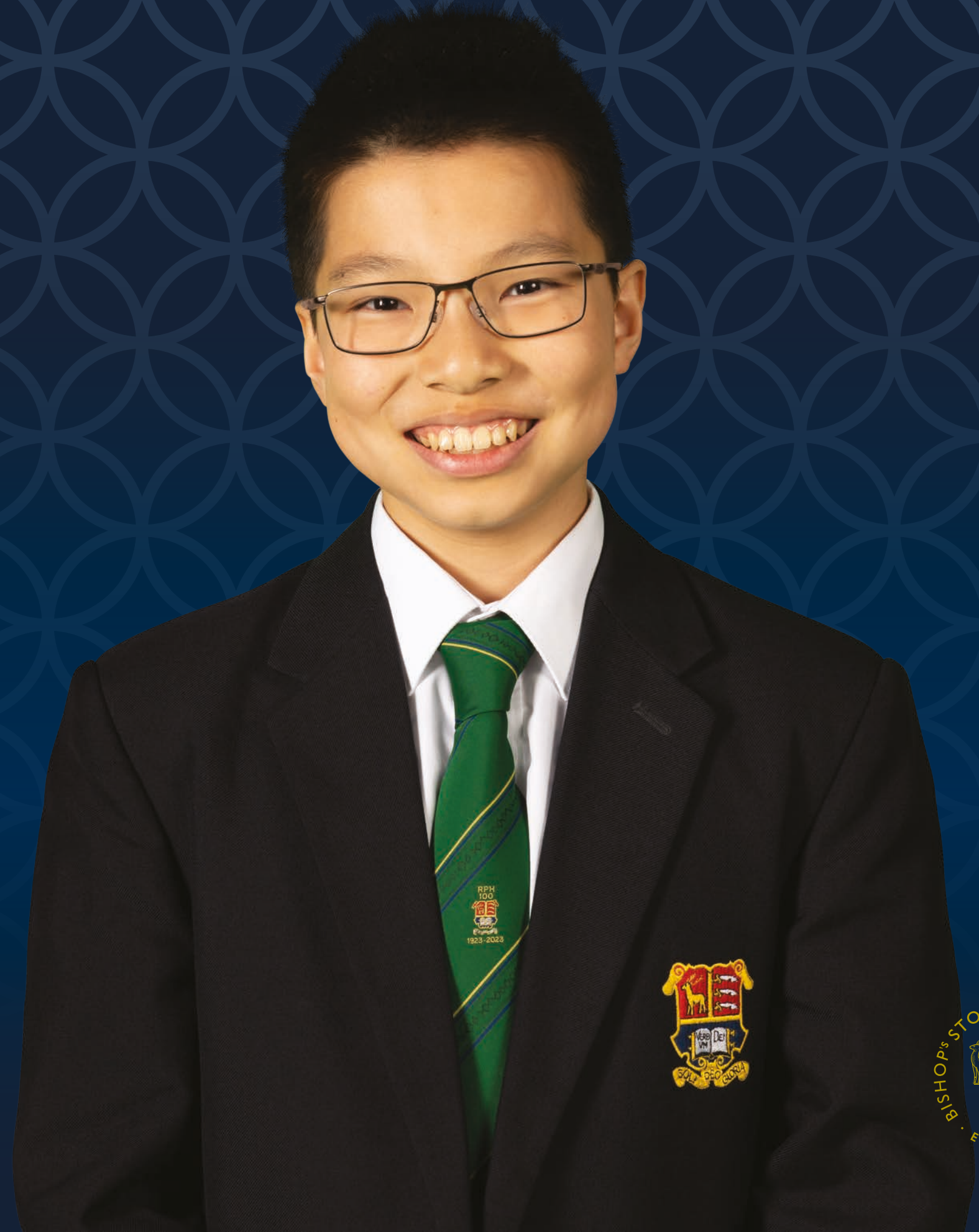

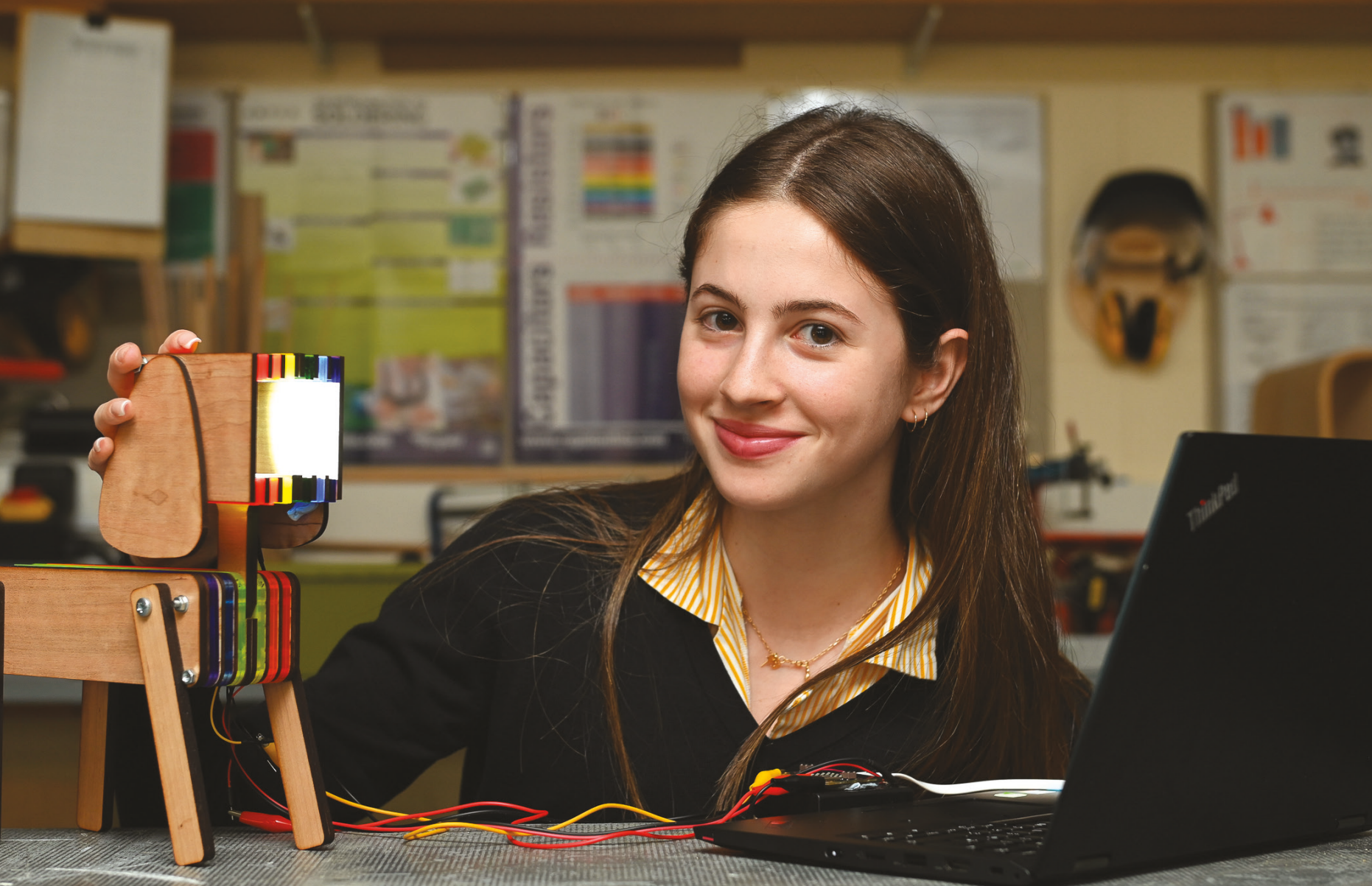

Outside the classroom there is a vast range of activities for your child to engage in to ignite new passions. Whether that's on the pitch or in the studio, there is something to interest everyone.

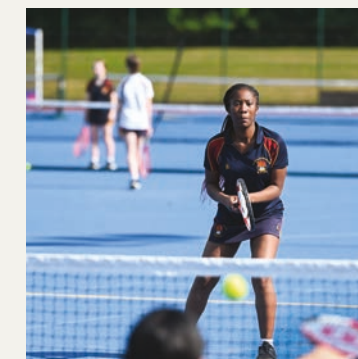
