OUR CAMPUS

Set in 130 acres of beautiful grounds, our campus is a wonderful blend of heritage and modernity.

State of the art facilities including the Senior School art department, the swimming pool and boarding houses, mix seamlessly across a backdrop of iconic buildings such as the Ferguson Building and School House, both built in 1890, and the Memorial Hall, built in 1922.

Each of our three schools have dedicated classrooms and hall spaces for assemblies and events. Whilst still a part of our campus, our Pre-Prep is situated in a quiet corner of our site, in its own dedicated building, with a playground and outdoor learning space. Our Prep School also has its own classrooms, whilst still sharing many facilities with our Senior School such as the swimming pool, music department, theatre and more. Our Senior School and Sixth Form makes up the rest of our campus, with numerous classroom buildings, houses, and a dedicated Sixth Form Learning Centre.

Across all sections of the school, we offer an environment that is inclusive, caring, and kind. Staff have access to a large common room and resource rooms. Our dedicated staff kitchens always have complimentary tea and coffee available, and a hot or cold lunch is provided throughout term time. Staff make full use of the facilities available on campus, and regularly enjoy school and social events.



BENEFITS OF SERVICE

At the heart of the College, are our people. It is the energy and dedication of our talented staff, and their enthusiasm to go that extra mile, which creates the opportunities, experiences, and forward looking approach and adds immeasurable value to the education we provide.

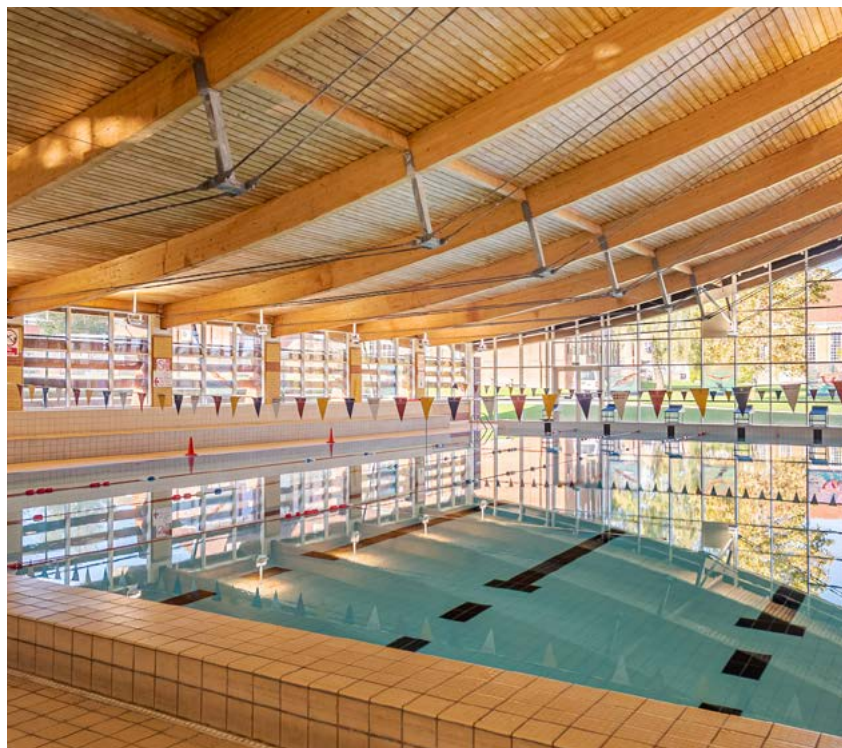
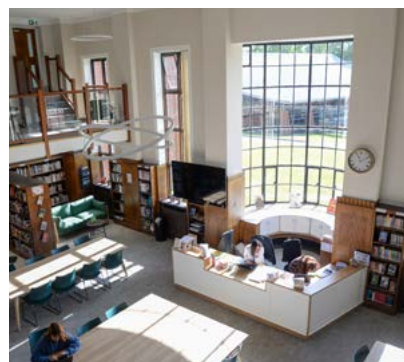
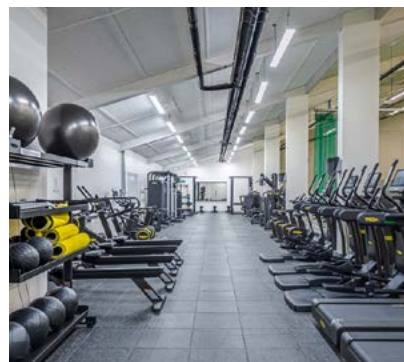
We offer a range of benefits to our staff that include:

Salary and pension

We offer generous salaries and eligible Professional Services staff are able to join the College Pension Scheme, we operate the TPS for teachers. There is an onsite Pensions Advisor who will help you decide what is the best scheme for you.

30 days annual leave (pro rata)

We think balancing work and personal life is important, which is why all 52-week staff enjoy 30 days holiday from their first day of employment.



Life insurance

Employees who have joined the College Pension Scheme, will also receive life insurance. This means that if the worst happens, your family may be eligible to receive a lump sum based on your salary.

College fees discount

Children of staff, who meet the College's entry criteria, may be eligible for school fee remission in accordance with our policy.

Complimentary lunch

Our dining hall is open to all staff during term time lunchtimes, and you can eat in or take away a delicious selection of hot and cold food.

College gym, swimming pool and library membership

As an employee, you will enjoy access to a range of facilities, including our state of the art gym, swimming pool and beautiful libraries.

Cycle to work scheme

We provide access to enable you to purchase a bike and cycling equipment in a salary sacrifice scheme.

Onsite parking

We have ample parking for staff to use. Employees are given a parking permit during their induction.

Family friendly

We run enhanced maternity, paternity and family friendly schemes and will always consider requests for flexible working.

Employee Assistance Program

Our Employee Assistance Program gives all staff access to a 24-hour helpline, for all personal and work problems that might come up. If needed, up to six counselling sessions can be provided as part of this.

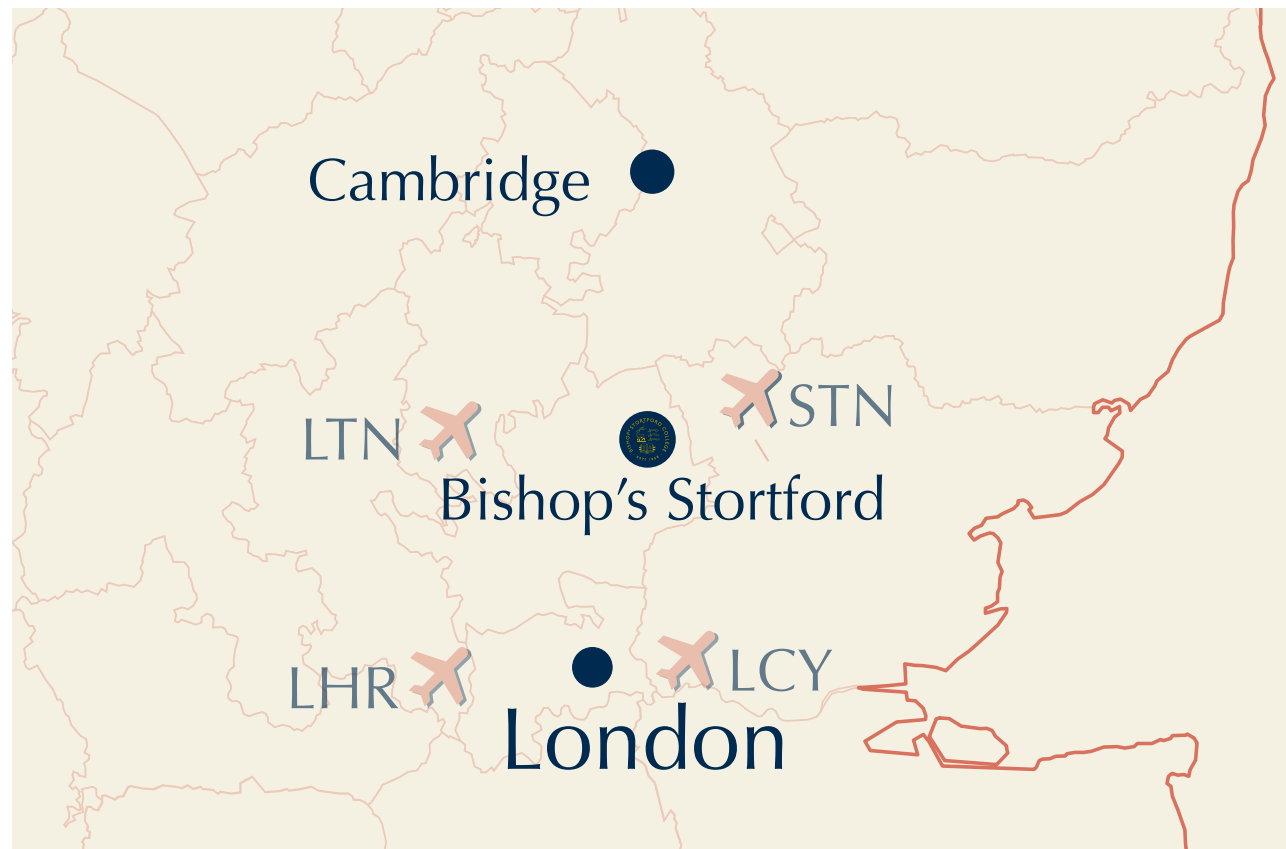
LIVING AND WORKING IN BISHOP'S STORTFORD

Bishop's Stortford is an historic market town in Hertfordshire, just west of the M11 motorway on the county boundary with Essex. It is situated between two cities; 23 miles north is the city of Cambridge, and 27 miles south is central London. This central location means that the town is well connected to the rest of the UK via both road and rail network, and internationally with Stansted Airport under five miles away, and other London airports within easy access.

In addition to many staff who choose to live in the town or within Hertfordshire, our employees easily commute to the College from London and neighbouring counties, such as Cambridgeshire, Middlesex, Essex, Bedfordshire, and Suffolk. HOW TO FIND US



By rail Our nearest mainline station is Bishop's Stortford (five minutes by taxi to/from the College) with regular service connections to London, Cambridge, and Stansted Airport. Taxis are available for hire outside the main entrance of Bishop's Stortford railway station and a bus service is available. The College is also within 20 minutes' walk of the station.

By bus There are several bus routes which serve the College including the 311, 386, 509 and 510.
